- 1. The Controller of your personal data is Gas Storage Poland sp. z o.o. (GSP) Polska Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Dębogórze, ul. Rumska 28, 81-198 Dębogórze, Poland
- 2. Contact with GSP is possible via e-mail to gsp@gas-storage.pl or in writing to: Gas Storage Poland Sp. z o.o., Warsaw Office, Al. Jana Pawła II 70, 00-175 Warsaw.
- 3. GSP has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted by e-mail: iodo@gas-storage.pl on any matter concerning the processing of personal data.
- 4. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of ensuring security and order at the site the basis for the possessing is a legitimate interest of GSP (Article 6(1)(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 GDPR). The legitimate interest pursued by the GSP is to ensure the security of the persons staying at the site and to ensure the security of the facilities, including the security of the GSP's property.
- Your personal data will be shared with the providers of physical protection and reception desk services retained by GSP as well as the video surveillance system providers.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored for the period of 2 years of the date of your visit to the location concerned. The processing period may be extended from time to time by the period of limitation of claims, if the processing of your personal data is necessary for the Controller to establish or pursue possible claims or defend against such claims.
- You have the right to access the content of the data and to request their rectification, erasure, restriction of the processing, as well as the right to object to the processing of the data.
- 8. You also have the right to file a complaint with the competent supervisory authority responsible for personal data protection (in Poland to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, Warsaw), if you find that the processing of your personal data violates the personal data protection regulations, and specifically the provisions of the GDPR.
- 9. You have the right to object to the processing of personal data for the purpose set out in section 4(a) above on grounds relating to your particular situation.
- 10. The provision of the data is required by the Controller to enable your access to the location, including, where appropriate, to an area covered by video surveillance. Refusal to provide the data will preclude your access to the location.
